RESOLUTION 2025-23

A resolution authorizing a change order for the contract approved in Resolution 2024-17 with Wintrow Rail to replace crossties, surface track areas, remove switches and straighten rail track, and create a ditch line to properly move water away from track in an area subjected to minor mudslides based on Federal Railroad Administration (FRA) requirements.

WHEREAS, METRO entered into a contract with Wintrow Rail in the amount of \$174,449.48 for FRA Rail Inspection Repairs.

WHEREAS, Due to setbacks with weather causing elevation deviations and warp conditions, and the additional stone needed the project cost increased to \$198,091.93.

WHEREAS, METRO is requesting a change order in the amount of \$23,642.45 which represents the additional material cost.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of METRO Regional Transit Authority that:

- 1. The Chief Executive Officer/Secretary-Treasurer is hereby authorized to execute said change order in an amount not to exceed \$23,642.45.
- 2. RESOLUTION 2025-24

A resolution establishing an overall Disadvantaged Business Enterprise goal of 1.0% for 2026-2028 Federal Fiscal Years.

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Board of Trustees of the METRO Regional Transit Authority to ensure that all Disadvantaged Business Enterprises, as defined in 49CFR Part 26, shall have a maximum opportunity to participate in all aspects of procurement of supplies, equipment, construction and services let by the Authority, and

WHEREAS, these goals are equal to the stated percentages of the federally funded portion of the contractible operating and capital expenses of the Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of METRO Regional Transit Authority that:

- 1. A goal of 1.0% is hereby established for the Federal Fiscal Years 2026-2028 for Disadvantaged Business Enterprise participation in METRO's federal procurement of supplies, equipment, construction and service contracts.
